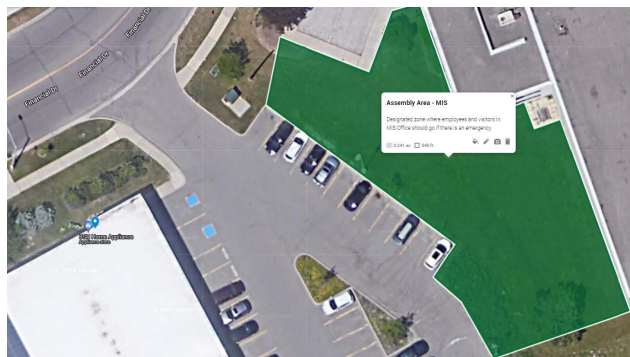

First-Aid:

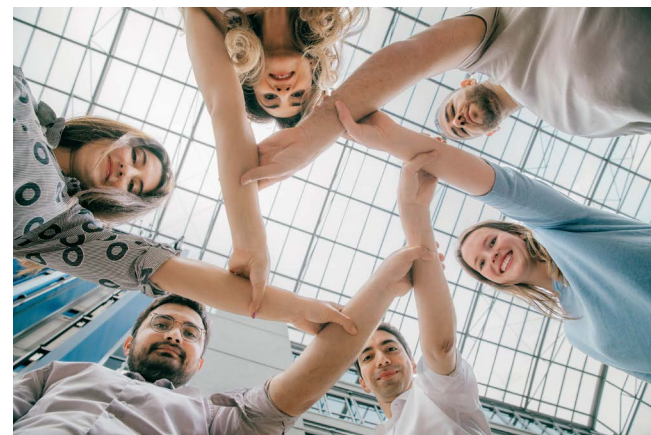
- There is a first aid kit in the building. A list of first aid trained associates is posted besides it.
 1. First-aid room located in the copy room and an AED is available here.

In the event of a fire:

- An audible alarm will sound.
- Begin evacuation through closest exit as depicted on the evacuation map to the right.
- Report to your host (the person whom you are visiting) or an Emergency Response Team member.
- Do not leave premises.
- Do not return into the building until all clear is given by Emergency Response Team or Authorities.

- Ask staff if you are unsure about the required safety gear for your visit.

4. Restricted Areas:

- Do not enter areas marked as restricted or without proper authorization.
- Follow all posted safety signs and warnings.

5. Hazardous Materials:

- Stay clear of areas containing hazardous materials or equipment.
- Report any spills or leaks immediately to onsite personnel.

6. Accident Reporting:

- Report any accidents or incidents to the nearest staff member.
- If injured, seek immediate medical attention and notify staff.

7. Parking and Traffic Guidelines:

- Please park only in designated visitor parking areas

8. Questions or Concerns:

- If you have any safety-related questions or concerns, please approach your designated BSH-CDN contact person.
- Report any observed hazards or unsafe conditions immediately.
