


The standard installation is done by sliding the hood onto the guide rails.



Alternatively, the hood can also be installed in a furniture cutout from below, for example, if a light panel is mounted below the cabinet. In this case, installation requires a second person.

If you love the look of your cabinets, you'll adore the **Integrated Design Hood**. When in use, only an elegant glass panel is visible above the hob. Switch it off and fold it away (Series 4 & 6), and it virtually disappears.

Behind its minimalist front lies generous capacity. Thanks to its innovative T-shaped design, the hood provides space for up to **20 kg – 10 kg on each side**. Perfect for full-size containers, cookbooks, and other kitchen essentials you want within easy reach. Clear your counters and restore your kitchen's clean lines.

Super-smart hood, super-smooth installation.

The Integrated Design Hood is full of advanced technology, yet installation couldn't be simpler – even in an existing kitchen. It's the perfect replacement choice when upgrading your old built-in extractor hood. Thoughtfully engineered down to the smallest detail, it makes setup effortless – whether with a frontal installation (the standard case) or installed in a furniture cutout from below (in case a light panel is additionally mounted). While the frontal installation can easily be carried out by a single person, the alternative method typically requires two people. The following pages demonstrate just how straightforward the process is.





The right tools make installation a breeze.

To ensure smooth a installation of your new Integrated Design Hood, we recommend having the following tools at hand:



1. Multi Cutter

(e.g. Bosch GOP 18V-34 Professional)



2. Cordless Drill/Driver

(e.g. Bosch GSR 18V-90 C Professional)

- 5. Folding Rule / Measuring Tape
- 6. Bradwal
- 7. Utility Knife



3. Akku-Stichsäge

(e.g. GST 12V-70 Professional)



4. Bit Set

including Torx T20 and allen key 2.5 mm (e.g. Bosch 32-piece bit set)



Color-matching adhesive tape

(to cover exposed edges and blend with furniture surfaces)



Expert Tip:

For easier measurement and to check the fitting accuracy, remove the upper cabinet doors if necessary.

The Integrated Design Hood is particularly well-suited for replacing an existing canopy or telescopic hood. To ensure compatibility, check the wall cabinet dimensions in advance to confirm that installation of the IDH is possible.

- Remove the old appliance according to the installation instructions.
- Remove the spice rack and/or the intermediate shelf and any firmly glued parts, if present.

Expert Tip:

For simple and clean separation of bonded joints, use a multi-cutter, such as the Bosch Cordless Multi-Cutter GOP 18V-34 Professional.

Check the cutout for the exhaust pipe and adjust it if necessary to match the IDH dimensions. In exhaust mode, the outlet may be positioned either outside the cupboard or inside at the back. If the outlet is placed inside the cupboard, the center of the exhaust





Cut the lower filler strips according to the cupboard depth and mount those accordingly.

Expert Tip:

The lower filler strip along the appliance channel is only available in Series 6 and 8. Channel depth adjustments are available across all value classes.






Install the grease filter, mount the cupboard door, and connect the power supply.

Expert Tip:

As the final step, install the chimney extension to serve as a decorative cover for the exhaust pipe.

pipe must be at least 480 mm above the bottom edge of the cupboard (minimum cupboard height: 560 mm).

- · Place the installation aid inside the cabinet and mark the fixing points.
- Pre-drill the fixing points with a bradawl.
- For a wall thickness of 16 mm: position the rails on the installation aids and securely fasten them to the cabinet side walls.
- For a wall thickness of 18 mm or 19 mm: fasten the rails without installation aid.

Expert Tips:

- · Conceal open areas using adhesive tape in a matching color.
- •The IDH can be installed with or without a back panel. However, if no back panel is present, we recommend adding one for improved aesthetics.

• If a back wall panel is present, trim the wall filler strip to the required depth (depending on the cabinet thickness and the back wall panel).



Slide the appliance into the cabinet and tighten the threaded pins.

Expert Tip:

After the appliance sits in the cabinet and the threaded pins are tightened, attach the additional screws on the right and left using a screwdriver, to stabilise the cabinet walls.

Replacement of a Canopy Hood

To replace a canopy hood with the Integrated Design Hood (IDH), proceed as follows:

- Suspend the cupboard.
- Prepare the cutout in the bottom of the cupboard: adjust width and depth according to the IDH dimensions.
- Check the cutout for the duct connection
- Cut the lower filler strip to match the cupboard depth and attach it to the appliance (only lower filler strip can be mounted; wall filler strip and channel depth adjustement cannot be installed).
- · Secure the appliance with two screws per side into the cupboard's side walls.

- Install the cupboard, including the appliance, in the kitchen unit.

No matter which wall cabinet solution your kitchen has, standard clip door, folding lift door, or swing door, the Integrated Design Hood will fit.



Standard clip door

If a permanently fixed shelf panel is present in a standard clip door cabinet, we recommend reusing it as a storage shelf in the center of the wall cabinet along with the Integrated Design Hood. This not only creates additional practical storage space but also increases the stability of the cabinet unit.

Folding lift door with spice rack

With a folding lift door, the hinges are mounted on the top panel of the wall cabinet, which unfortunately makes it impossible to install a chimney extension. As a small workaround, we recommend shortening the existing spice rack and reinstalling it in the upper section of the cabinet, where it can serve as a cover panel for the round duct.



Swing door with hinge bar

In some swing door configurations, the hinges on the top panel of the wall cabinet are additionally connected by a horizontal hinge bar. This bar typically obstructs the path of a standard round duct. However, there is a practical solution: we recommend placing a round-tofl at duct adapter directly on the outlet of the Integrated Design Hood. This allows the use of a fl at duct, which is slim enough to be routed past the hinge bar.
