Additional programmes

Programme selector	Description/Application	Programme length (mins. approx.) ***
Rinse	Rinse cycle, with spin. For starching or rinsing handwashed garments. Maximum spin speed: 800 or 1000 or 1200 rpm (depending on model).	15
Spin	Cycle for spinning handwashed garments. Washing or rinsing water is pumped out before spinning the laundry. Maximum spin speed: 800 or 1000 or 1200 rpm (depending on model).	10
Drain	Pumps out the rinse water after completion of a wash programme with the Rinse hold option. Careful washing of delicate items.	2

^{*} In all programmes without pre-wash, put the detergent in chamber II (left).

More detailed information can be found in the instructions on installation and use of the machine, which should be read carefully, paying attention to the safety information they include.

^{**} Share the detergent between chambers I and II.

^{***} The times given in the table for the programme lengths are indicative only and may vary according to pressure, water hardness and temperature, the ambient temperature where the machine has been installed, the type and size of load, the detergent used, fluctuations in mains voltage and the additional functions selected.
