


Adjusting the water softening system*

Ask your water supply company what the water hardness is and enter ...



* only before the first wash or if the water hardness has been changed

Read off the correct setting for your water hardness ...


Quickly sorted ...

How to adjust the water softening system

- Rotate the programme button from the 12 o'clock position by one notch
- Switch on the main switch and hold down for at least 3 seconds. The digital display indicates the current set hardness value (factory setting 4).
- Change the set value by rotating the programme selector (0–7).
- Switch off the main switch. The set value is saved.



Unscrew the lid.



Only before using the dishwasher for the first time pour approx. 11/ 2 pt water into the salt opening.



Pour in max. 1.5 kg / 3 lb 5 oz salt (never detergent!)



Screw on the lid. Switch on dishwasher immediately.

Everything is sparkling clean ...



Press mark 1, lift up lid 2.



Refill whenever level indicator is light!



Pour in rinse aid.



Close the lid. CLICK!

Very dirty dishes, a lot of detergent ...



basket, programme starts automatically. extra 5g of cleaning unlocks.



Time reduction/ time saving

...shortens the cleaning time, reduces the drying.



Upper basket cleaning ...Only the crockery in the upper basket is cleaned

Time selection ...switches on as soon as

Strainers ... Check if required, clean

Cleaning the waste-water pump *

- * With some models
- Ladle out water and remove filters
 - Unscrew cover (Torx T20)
- Check area of fan impeller for foreign objects
- Screw in cover and insert filters


Spray arms ... Remove blockages/deposits



Pull lower arm upwards ...



Unscrew upper arm ...



Clean spray nozzles under flowing water (perhaps with toothpick) ...



Screw in upper arm

Too little detergent

Discoloration caused by food colourings (tomato sauce)

Follow manufacturer's instructions (detergent).

Discoloration is harmless; subsequent rinse cycles will cause it to fade.

Rust on the cutlery

Cutlery not rust-resistant Hard knife blades are more susceptible

Extraneous rust

- Use dishwasher-proof cutlery.
- Never wash rusting parts in the appliance.

Utensils are not clean

Possible causes

Utensils are situated close together or one above the other

Too little detergent

Unsuitable programme selected Spray arm nozzles blocked

Filters dirty, not seated firmly

Spray arms blocked

Remedial

Follow manufacturer's instructions (detergent).

Separate the utensils, prevent contact

Select a more intensive programme.

Clean the spray arms (see above).

Clean the filters (see above).

Arrange the utensils so that the spray arms can rotate freely.

Stains and streaks

Rinse-aid dosage too high / too low

Streaks: reduce dosage.

Water or limescale stains: increase dosage.

Milky film on the utensils Water softening system incorrectly set; (removable) No salt

Milky film, glasses Glasses not dishwasher-proof cloudy / dull (not removable)

Correctly set water softening system.

Refill with salt.

Use dishwasher-proof glasses.

Use a detergent suitable for glasses.

Interrupting the programme ... Terminating the programme ...

- Switch off the main switch.
- To continue, close the door. Switch on the main switch again.
- While the programme is running, rotate the programme selector to the Reset pos. After approx. 3 seconds the digital display indicates 0.
- The programme sequence lasts approx. 1 min.
- When the programme has run, switch off the main switch.

Loading the dishwasher correctly ...

Dishwasher-proof utensils (not soiled with ash, wax, lubricating grease, ink or adhesive labels; remove large remnants of jam, milk products and food according to the operating instructions and check that the spray arms can rotate freely.
