
- Wipe with a soft, damp cloth.
- Do not use any abrasive cloths, sponges or cleaning agents (stainless-steel cleaner).
- Immediately remove washing and cleaning agent residue.
- Do not clean the appliance with a water jet.

Clean the detergent drawer ...

... if it contains detergent or fabric softener residue.

- 1. Pull out, depress insert, completely remove.
- 2. Open the cover.
- 3. Clean with water and dry.
- Close and lock the cover (place cylinder on guide pin).
- 5. Insert detergent drawer.







Leave detergent drawer open so that residual water can evaporate.

Drum

Leave washing machine door open so that the drum can dry out.

Rust stains - use chlorine-free cleaning agent, not steel wool.

Descaling No washing in the machine!

Descale according to the instructions of the descaling agent-manufacturer, not required for correct detergent dosage.

Information on the display panel depending on model

F:16	Close the washing machine door properly; washing may be caught.
F:17	Turn the tap on fully, supply hose kinked/jammed; clean filter -> <i>page 10</i> , water pressure too low.



Detergent-solution pump

Set programme selector to Off, pull out the mains plug.

1. Open and remove service flap.



2. Take drainage hose out of the holder and pull out of the housing. Remove sealing cap, allow detergent solution to flow out.

Press on sealing cap and insert drainage hose into the holder.

For models without drainage hose:

- 2* Carefully unscrew pump cover until the detergent solution begins to run out. When the service flap is half full.
 - screw back the pump cover and empty the service flap. Repeat steps until all the detergent solution has run out.
- Carefully unscrew the pump cover (residual water).
- 4. Clean the interior, pump cover thread and pump housing (fan impeller in the detergent-solution pump must rotate).

- Reinsert and screw on pump cover.
- Insert and close service flap.
- To prevent unused detergent from flowing into the outlet during the next wash: Pour 1 litre of water into dispenser II and select the **Drain** yet programme.

Drainage hose at the siphon

Set programme selector to Off, pull out the mains plug.

- 1. Loosen the hose clamp, carefully remove the drainage hose (residual water).
- 2. Clean the drainage hose and siphon connecting piece.
- 3. Reattach the drainage hose and secure the connection with the hose clamp.



Filters in the water supply



Risk of electric shock! Do not immerse Agua-Stop safety device in water (contains electric valve).

Release water pressure in the supply hose:

- 1. Turn off the tap!
- 2. Select any programme (except Spin 6/Drain).
- 3. Press Start ①. Leave programme for approx. 40 seconds.
- 4. Set programme selector to Off.
- 5. Remove hose from tap.
- 6. Clean filter with small brush.
- 7. Depending on the model, remove hose from the rear of the appliance and clean the filter.






8. Connect the hose and check for leaks.



What to do if ...

Water is running out.	Correctly attach/replace drainage hose.Tighten screw-fitting on the supply hose.
Water not flowing in. Detergent not washed in.	 Start ◆ not selected? Tap not open? Filter blocked? Clean filter -> page 10. Supply hose kinked or jammed?
Washing machine door cannot be opened.	 Safety function active. Wait approx. 2 minutes. → (Rinse hold = without final spin) selected?
Programme does not start.	Start ◆ selected?Door closed?
Detergent solution is not drained.	 Clean detergent-solution pump -> page 10. Clean outlet pipe and/or drainage hose.
Washing not spun correctly.	- Distribute small and large items of washing in the drum.

Water not visible in the drum.	- Not a fault - water below the visible area.
