The values deviate from the indicated values depending on water pressure, water hardness, water inlet temperature, room temperature, type and amount of washing and degree of soiling, utilised detergent, fluctuations in the mains voltage and selected additional functions.



- Risk of electric shock! Pull out the mains plug! of explosion! No solvents!

## Machine housing, control panel

- Wipe with a soft, damp cloth.
- Do not use any abrasive cloths, sponges or cleaning agents (stainless-steel cleaner).
- Immediately remove washing and cleaning agent residue.
- Do not clean the appliance with a water jet.

## Clean the detergent drawer ...

... if it contains detergent or fabric softener residue.






3. Clean with water and dry.

4. Close and lock the cover (place cylinder on quide pin).

5. Insert detergent drawer.







Leave detergent drawer open so that residual water can evaporate.

#### Drum

Leave washing machine door open so that the drum can dry out.

Rust stains - use chlorine-free cleaning agent, not steel wool.

### **Descaling** No washing in the machine!

Descale according to the instructions of the descaling agent-manufacturer, not required for correct detergent dosage.

# Information on the display panel depending on model

A signal sounds and indicator lights for the spin speed flash:

- Close the washing machine door properly; washing may be caught.
- O Detergent solution pump blocked; O Clean the detergent solution pump  $\bigcirc$  -> page 10.
- Drainage hose / waste pipe blocked: Clean the drainage hose at the
- siphon -> Page 10.

Motor fault! Call customer service!

O clean filter -> page 10,

o water pressure too low.

O supply hose kinked/jammed;

# Maintenance




- Risk of scalding! Allow detergent solution to cool down! Tum off the tap!

## Detergent-solution pump

Set programme selector to **Off**, pull out the mains plug.

1. Open and remove service flap.



2. Take drainage hose out of the holder and pull out of the housing. Remove sealing cap, allow detergent solution to flow out.

Press on sealing cap and insert drainage hose into the holder.

For models without drainage hose:

2\* Carefully unscrew pump cover until the detergent solution begins to run out. When the service flap is half full. screw back the pump cover and empty the service flap. Repeat steps until all the detergent solution has run out.



4. Clean the interior, pump cover thread and pump housing (fan impeller in the detergent-solution pump must rotate).



- Reinsert and screw on pump cover.
- Insert and close service flap.
- To prevent unused detergent from flowing into the outlet during the next wash: Pour 1 litre of water into dispenser II and select the www Drain programme.

### Filters in the water supply

Risk of electric shock! Do not immerse Aqua-Stop safety device in water (contains electric valve).

Release water pressure in the supply hose:

- 1. Turn off the tap!
- Select any programme (except © Spin / wy Drain).
- 3. Press  $\diamondsuit$  **Start**. Leave programme for approx. 40 seconds.
- 4. Set programme selector to Off.
- 5. Remove hose from tap.
- Clean filter with small brush.
- 7. Depending on the model, remove hose from the rear of the appliance and clean the filter.



8. Connect the hose and check for leaks.

## Drainage hose at the siphon

Set the programme selector to Off, disconnect the mains plug.

- 1. Loosen the hose clamp, carefully remove the drainage hose (residual water).
- 2. Clean the drainage hose and siphon connecting piece.
- 3. Reattach the drainage hose and secure the connection with the hose clamp.








