#### Protecting the washing and the machine

- Empty pockets.
- Remove metal parts (paper clips, etc.).
- Wash delicates in the net/bag (tights, curtains, underwired bras).
- Close zips, button up covers.
- Brush sand out of pockets and collars.
- Remove curtain fittings or include in the net/bag.



Set programme selector to  $\mathring{\wedge}$  Easy-Care 60 °C and select  $\textcircled{\wedge}$  Start. At the end of the programme set the programme selector to Off.

### Machine housing, control panel

- Wipe with a soft, damp cloth.
- Do not use abrasive cloths, sponges or detergents (stainless steel cleaner).
- Immediately remove washing and cleaning agent residue.
- Do not clean the appliance with a water jet.

### Clean the detergent drawer ...

- ... if it contains detergent or fabric softener residue.
- 1. Pull out, depress insert, take out drawer all the way. Take out insert: using your finger, press insert upwards.
- Clean detergent dispenser and insert with water and a brush and dry.
- Attach insert and lock into position (push cylinder onto quide pin).
- Insert detergent drawer.



Leave detergent drawer open so that residual water can evaporate.

#### Drum

Leave washing machine door open so that the drum can dry out. Rust stains - use chlorine-free cleaning agent, not steel wool.

#### **Descaling** No washing in the machine!

Descale according to the instructions of the descaling agent-manufacturer, not required for correct detergent dosage.

#### Emergency release, e.g. if power failure occurs

The programme continues running when the power is restored. If the washing is still to be removed, the door can be opened as described below:

### Risk of scalding!

Wash liquor and washing may be hot. If required, leave to cool down.

Do not reach into the drum in case it is still rotating.

Do not open the door if you can still see water through the glass.

- 1. Select programme selector to Off, pull out the mains plug.
- Drain detergent solution -> Page 10.
- Pull down emergency release with a tool and release. Door can then be opened.

## Detergent solution pump

Set programme selector to **Off**, pull out the mains plug.



For models with drainage hose:

2. Take drainage hose out of the holder and pull out of the housing. Place a container on the floor. Remove sealing cap, allow detergent solution to flow out. Press on sealing cap and insert drainage hose into the holder.

For models without drainage hose:

2\* Carefully unscrew pump cover until the detergent solution begins to run out. When the service flap is half full.

screw back the pump cover and empty the service flap. Repeat steps until all the detergent solution has run out.

- Carefully unscrew the pump cover (residual water).
- Clean the interior, pump cover thread and pump housing (fan impeller in the detergent solution pump must rotate).
- Reinsert and screw on pump cover.
- Insert and close service flap.

To prevent unused detergent from flowing into the outlet during the next wash: Pour 1 litre of water into dispenser II and start the y Drain programme.

### Drainage hose on the siphon

Set programme selector to **Off**, pull out the mains plug.

- 1. Loosen hose clip, carefully remove drainage hose (residual water).
- 2. Clean drainage hose and siphon spigot.
- 3. Re-attach drainage hose and secure connection point with hose clip.



### Filters in the water supply

Risk of electric shock! Do not immerse Agua-Stop safety device in water (contains electric valve).

Release water pressure in the supply hose:

- **1.** Turn off the tap!
- Select any programme (except @ Spin/ Drain).
- 3. Select  $\diamondsuit$  Start. Leave programme for approx. 40 seconds.
- 4. Set programme selector to Off. Pull out the mains plug! Clean the filter: According to model:

1. Remove hose from tap.

Clean filter with small brush.

and/or for standard and Agua-Secure models:

Remove hose from the rear of the appliance. Take out filter with pliers and clean.

Connect the hose and check for leaks.














