Cottons: Hard-wearing textiles, heat-resistant textiles made of cotton or linen Note: The Speed setting is suitable as a short programme for lightly soiled laundry.	7 kg/4** kg; - - (cold) - 90 °C - -- (Rinse Stop), 0 - 1400* rpm ≡ , Water Plus/Rinse Plus
Cottons Eco: Hard-wearing fabrics, heat-resistant textiles made of cotton or linen Energy-optimised washing by reducing the temperature while achieving a comparable washing result for the Cottons programme. Note: The washing temperature is lower than the selected temperature. If you want to achieve a higher water temperature, use the Cottons programme with a higher temperature as required.	7 kg; - - (cold) - 90 °C - -- (Rinse Stop), 0 - 1400* rpm Water Plus/Rinse Plus
Easy-Care: Textiles made of synthetic materials or blended fabrics	4 kg; - - (cold) - 60 °C - -- (Rinse Stop), 0 - 1200* rpm ≡ , Water Plus/Rinse Plus
Wool: Hand or machine-washable wool or rich-wool textiles. Especially gentle wash programme to prevent shrinkage, longer programme pauses (textiles rest in wash liquor). Notes ■ Wool is of animal origin, e.g.: Angora, alpaca, llama, sheep. ■ Use a detergent that is suitable for machine-washing wool.	2 kg; - - (cold) - 40 °C - -- (Rinse Stop), 0 - 800 rpm -
SuperQuick 15'/30': Extra short programme of approx. 15/30 minutes, suitable for small items of lightly soiled laundry Note: When selecting the Speed setting, the programme SuperQuick 15' is run.	2/3.5 kg; - - (cold) - 40 °C - -- (Rinse Stop), 0 - 1200* rpm ≡
Mixed Load: Mixed load of cottons and synthetic fabrics	4 kg; - - (cold) - 40 °C - -- (Rinse Stop), 0 - 1400* rpm ≡ , Water Plus/Rinse Plus
Night Wash: Especially quiet programme for washing during the night; suitable for cotton, linen, synthetic and blended fabrics Note: Final buzzer deactivated.	4 kg; - - (cold) - 40 °C - -- (Rinse Stop), 0 - 1400* rpm ≡ , Water Plus/Rinse Plus

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Rinse/Spin/Drain: Combined extra programme for rinsing and spinning the laundry, and draining the rinsing water Notes ■ The Water Plus/Rinse Plus setting is preset by default. ■ Only to be rinsed, set the Spin speed to 0. ■ Only to be spun, deactivate Water Plus/Rinse Plus and, if required, adjust the spin speed. ■ Only to be emptied, set the Spin speed to 0 and deactivate Water Plus/Rinse Plus.	-; - - -- (Rinse Stop), 0 - 1400* rpm Water Plus/Rinse Plus
Drum Clean: Programme for cleaning and caring for the drum and the outer tub, e.g. before running the first wash cycle, if washing frequently at a low temperature (40 °C or lower) or if an odour has developed after a prolonged period of non-use. The Drum Clean indicator lamp  flashes when you have not used a programme of 60 °C or higher for a long time. Notes ■ Run the drum-care programme without any laundry. ■ Use washing powder or a detergent containing bleach. To prevent foaming, only use half the amount of detergent recommended by the detergent manufacturer. Do not use detergents designed for woollens or delicates.	0 kg; 90 °C 1200* rpm -
Delicates/Silk: For delicate, washable textiles, e.g. made of silk, satin, synthetic fibres or blended fabrics (e.g. silk blouses, silk scarf) Note: Use a detergent suitable for machine-washing delicates or silk.	2 kg; - - (cold) - 40 °C - -- (Rinse Stop), 0 - 800 rpm   , Water Plus/Rinse Plus
Duvet: Machine-washable items stuffed with synthetic fibres, such as pillows, quilts and bedspreads; also suitable for items stuffed with down Note: Wash large items separately. Use a detergent designed for delicates and follow the instructions on the item's care label. Use detergent sparingly.	2 kg (Down 1.5 kg); - - (cold) - 60 °C - -- (Rinse Stop), 0 - 1200* rpm   , Water Plus/Rinse Plus
Sportswear: Sportswear and leisure wear made from microfibre fabrics Notes ■ Laundry must not be treated with fabric softener. ■ Before washing, clean the detergent drawer thoroughly (all compartments) to remove fabric-softener residue.	2 kg; - - (cold) - 40 °C - -- (Rinse Stop), 0 - 800 rpm   , Water Plus/Rinse Plus
Dark Wash: Dark textiles made of cotton and dark easy-care textiles. Note: Wash textiles inside out.	3.5 kg; - - (cold) - 40 °C - -- (Rinse Stop), 0 - 1200* rpm   , Water Plus/Rinse Plus
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Shirts: Non-iron shirts or blouses made of cotton, linen, synthetic fibres or blended fabrics	2 kg; - - (cold) - 60 °C
Notes	- - - (Rinse Stop), 0 - 800 rpm
■ Shirts/blouses are only given a short spin on the Less Ironing *** setting. Hang them up to dry while still dripping wet. → Self-smoothing effect	⇒   , Water Plus/Rinse Plus
■ Use the Delicates/Silk programme to wash shirts/blouses made of silk/delicate fabrics.	
Allergy+: Hard-wearing fabrics made of cotton or linen	6.5 kg; - - (cold) - 60 °C
Note: Particularly suited to washing items that need to be hygienically clean and especially kind to sensitive skin thanks to the longer wash cycle at a defined temperature, higher water level and longer spin cycle.	- - - (Rinse Stop), 0 - 1400* rpm

Efficiency test programmes for cotton fabrics

The following programmes (standard programmes, indicated by ) are suitable for cleaning normally soiled cotton fabrics and are the most efficient with respect to combined energy and water consumption.
