- Induction Cooktops Bosch induction cooktops are built using proprietary technology. This allows Bosch to bring revolutionary technologies to market such as AutoChef sensor cooking.
- **VitaFresh™ Technology** Available in Bosch French door refrigerators, VitaFresh technology automatically maintains the perfect balance of temperature, humidity and air circulation so produce stays fresher, longer, than when stored in a conventional refrigerator.

Sustainability plays an important role at Bosch home appliances and has been part of Bosch's DNA since its founding. Sustainability at Bosch appliances has evolved to acting in a responsible manner across the board – from manufacturing, to efficiency during product life and ensuring product recyclability when its life cycle is over.
